In the middle of the 1980's, there was a large number of undocumented Irish living in the United States. In response Irish immigrants, frustrated with their situation, formed the Irish Immigration Reform Movement (IIRM), which began to agitate for changes in immigration law. The highly successful lobbying efforts of the IIRM resulted in several positive legal changes through the introduction of the Morrison and Schumer visa schemes.

However, the IIRM realized that in addition to their legislative efforts, there was also a growing need for a center to provide day to day assistance for recent Irish immigrants. In response, the Emerald Isle Immigration Center (EIIC) was founded in 1988. Since then the Center has helped thousands apply for visas and receive green cards. It has also broadened its' scope of services and places great emphasis on civic empowerment and participation.

The Emerald Isle Immigration Center is a non-profit organization and is extremely grateful to the public for the support it receives for all its fundraising events.
