Deferred Action for Parental Accountability (DAPA)
and an extension of
Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)**

<p>Extension of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows individuals who entered the U.S. on or before 1-1-2010 and were under the age of 16 years to apply. Old age limit of 31 years is removed. • Requires continuous residence in the United States since January 1, 2010, rather than the prior requirement of June 15, 2007. • Physical presence at time of application and on 6-15-2012. • Undocumented as of 6-15-2012. • Meets high school, GED, currently in school or armed forces requirement. • No serious criminal convictions or serious offenses committed. • Extends the deferred action period and employment authorization to three years from the current two years. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can file approximately 90 days following the President's November 20, 2014, announcement. • If applicant can meet former age and entry requirements, can apply now. • Government fees of about \$465.
<p>Deferred Action For Parents Of U.S. Citizens And Lawful Permanent Residents</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent-child relationship established as of 11-20-2014. • Continuous residence in the U.S. since 1-1-2010 or earlier. • Physical presence in the U.S. with no valid immigration status on 11-20-2014 and when applying for status. • No serious criminal convictions or serious offenses committed; not "an enforcement priority". 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can file approximately 180 days following the President's November 20, 2014, announcement. • Government fees of about \$465.
